#### **Notes on Riding Attire**

Stirrups cannot be used with flat-bottomed shoes (such as tennis shoes). Since it's more difficult to ride without stirrups, riding boots or low-heeled shoes are strongly recommended. We have a few extra pairs of boots available for campers to use, but sizes vary. Open-toe shoes are not permitted.

Long jeans should be worn for riding. Wind pants and shorts are not permitted.

Camp Cherith will provide riding helmets, which all riders are required to wear. You're welcome to bring your own riding helmet, but bike helmets or other multipurpose helmets are not permitted.
