Corral Aide Application

You must register for camp to be eligible for this position.

Responsibilities

Morning:

- Herd in the horses and put them in their stalls.
- Mix feed and feed the horses.
- Groom the horses: curry and brush (making sure they're thoroughly clean), brush manes and tails, remove ticks, report any new wounds, wash out and treat old wounds as directed, pick hooves, saddle, fly wipe, bridle and tighten cinches
- Remove manure at the tack house, pole barn, and surrounding area.
- Sweep and clean up the tack house. Be sure equipment is clean and in order.

Afternoon (during the first half of free time):

- Remove manure at the arena and hitching rail.
- Assist with departing trail rides as needed.
- Remove manure on the trail between the arena and tack house.

Expectations

Be on time. This means being aware of your specific schedule and letting your counselor know when you are leaving to perform your corral aide duties.

Be willing to eat an early breakfast without other campers (cereal, toast, and juice will be set out for you) and to work during a portion of afternoon free time.

Be alert, respectful, and kind to the horses. They have feelings and personalities just as people do.

Work diligently. This position is a real job and requires commitment. Training will be provided.
